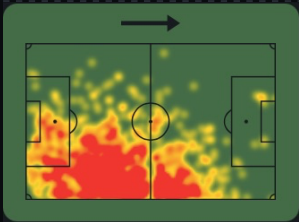

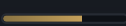

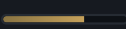

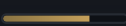

STRENGTHS

- Excels at winning headers in the defensive 3rd
- Reads the game well and steps into passing lanes

WEAKNESSES

- Can struggle physically with more experienced target men.
- Rarely contributes in attacking set-pieces or score goal like his defensive abilities on the defensive side of the pitch.

SCOUT RECOMMENDATION

Doi profiles as a high-upside, ball-playing center-back whose quantitative metrics highlight elite efficiency in aerial duels and a high volume of progressive, line-breaking distribution from the defensive third.

Tactically, he reads the game with advanced maturity, though data indicates a vulnerability in isolated physical duels against traditional target men and positional lapses when defending deep-block crosses. Financially valued between €0.6M and €1.3M, his acquisition remains highly viable despite a contract extending to June 2029; a structured loan-to-buy agreement featuring a 15–20% sell-on clause represents an optimal entry strategy.

Post-June 2027, following the expiration of his developmental loan at V-Varen Nagasaki, he should be aggressively targeted for transition into high-pressing, technically intensive European frameworks, specifically the **Dutch Eredivisie** for possession-heavy systems, or the or the **Belgian Pro League** and **German 2. Bundesliga** to accelerate his physical and defensive adaptation.
